

## **Nominating Committee Description:**

**Report to:** The NPTA President on matters relating to elected positions, awards, and growing our leaders.

**Committee Composition & Term:** Nominating committee consists of 3 elected members of the Chapter. Each elected member will serve a term of 3 years commencing after the annual business meeting in the year they are elected, with one member elected each year. The committee member with seniority serves as Chair.

**Position Objective:** To assist the APTA in identifying and growing future leaders of our organization, as well as recognizing those who have made contributions to our profession.

**Benefits:** The committee plays an important role in maintaining the integrity of our organization and profession by promoting and developing strong leadership.

**Specific Responsibilities:** The Nominating Committee will promote quality leadership for the chapter by providing quality candidates for the positions of the elected offices of the Chapter. The Nominating Committee responsibilities include providing candidates for the elected offices and special awards, checking candidate qualifications, and conducting chapter elections. Committee members may work together with other committees to help promote membership and the organization and create opportunities to develop strong future leadership.

**Time Commitment:** Estimated time commitment is approximately 10 hours per year. The heaviest time commitments for the committee will be from September through February as we work to recruit leadership and promote awards.

**Qualifications:** Must be an NPTA member in good standing.
